Dear Parent/Guardian,

The Winthrop Public Schools Residency Policy states that "students who are enrolled in the Winthrop Public Schools shall be required to re-establish residency prior to entering grades three (3), six (6) and nine (9).

This process is one of the safeguards used by the Winthrop Public Schools to ensure that all students enrolled in our schools are residents of the Town of Winthrop. Although the re-registration process may be an inconvenience to some families, we hope that residents understand that this is a valuable tool to ensure that all our students are in fact residents of the Town of Winthrop.

As a parent/guardian of a child/student entering grade **THREE**, **SIX and/or NINE**, you are **required** to fill out a Re-establish Residency Packet and provide the requested information prior to August 17, 2023 . Once you have gathered all the required documentation necessary to re-register, please deliver the completed packet of information to the school your child will be attending in the Fall. A staff member will be present to review the packet and answer any questions you may have regarding the requested documentation. Students will not be registered to attend the Winthrop Public Schools if the process has not been completed prior to the August 17, 2023, deadline. You are <u>not</u> required to share any financial information that is listed on the required documentation, and you may redact that information as you deem necessary. All documentation must identify your current registering address including but not limited to parent/guardian photo identification. If you include utility bills, the bill must be one that is dated within the past 30 days and contains the current registering address.

If you have any questions related to the process, please contact the secretary of the school your child will be attending in the Fall. Please see page 2 for the locations, dates and times that are available for you to complete this process.
