What We Covered in November:

Reading/ELA:

- Individual letters for Letterland: in depth look at letters and sounds. Letters covered: C, H, D, S, T, A, E
- Beginning blending simple c-v-c words (consonant-vowel-consonant, ex. cat)
- Heggerty: manipulate sounds, add/delete word parts, identifying a rhyme, letter recognition, Nursery rhyme repetition, chunking words: beginning sound- ending word part, beginning word part-ending sound.
