We currently have several different plans in place for each of the events. Following Governor Baker's next update on **Monday, May 18th**, our team will meet to finalize our plans. We will be reaching out to you by **Friday, May 22nd** with the final details regarding these events.

In addition, we have planned some new and exciting senior activities for our students that will take place on each of the next three Fridays in May. The details for the events will be finalized and emailed to students and families early this week.

I am hopeful that we will be able to give our seniors what they deserve; events and celebrations that are meaningful, unique, and unforgettable.
