- EL and reading services are limited in kindergarten. Bolster need in school improvement plan.

VI. Staff Survey

- Council members read and reviewed consolidated staff survey responses
 - Recommendations:
 - Include student and teacher technology in School Improvement Plan
 - School based professional development needs to be site based. Possible suggestions to make stronger? Surveys conducted.
 - Reassess SMART plan. Sticker awards seem to vary greatly from teacher to teacher. Bring back Smart Student of the Week
 - Introduce additional ALICE training. Once a year is not sufficient. Include Para's in training.
 - Classroom size not to exceed 22 students.
