Winthrop Public Schools Updated Health Protocols 2023-24

Please keep your child home from school if they display any of the following symptoms:

• Fever of 100 degrees or more, and until the child has had a normal temperature for 24 hours; without the use of Tylenol or Advil

- Vomiting or diarrhea during the night or in the morning before school
- Rash of unknown cause
- Signs of infection of the eyes, ears, nose, throat, skin or scalp. For example conjunctivitis or pink eye, open sores in the mouth, untreated strep throat, impetigo or open weeping wounds
- If on antibiotics for less than 12 hours for infectious conditions such as strep throat or conjunctivitis or impetigo

COVID Management

Please stay home from school, call primary care provider and get tested for COVID for any of the following symptoms: Symptomatic Individuals

- 1. Consult with your child's primary care provider
- 2. Covid 19 testing is recommended and if the initial test is negative, a second test within 48 hours is recommended
- 3. Can return if fever free for 24 hours without medication and symptoms have significantly improved
- 4. Mask is recommended until symptoms resolve

Please note we continue to support any individual who wishes to mask.

COVID Positive - If your child tests positive, please do the following:

Fever (100.0° Fahrenheit or higher), chills, or shaking chills

- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- New loss of taste or smell
- Muscle aches or body aches
- Cough (not due to other known cause, such as chronic cough)

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Sore throat, when in combination with other symptoms

- Nausea, vomiting, when in combination with other symptoms
- Headache, *when in combination with other symptoms*
- Fatigue, when in combination with other symptoms
- Nasal congestion or runny nose (not due to other known causes, such as allergies), when in combination with other symptoms

- 1. Notify the school nurse
- 2. Call your child's primary care provider for a doctor's note to excuse the absences

- 3. Keep your child at home through day 5. To count days for isolation, Day 0 is the first day of symptoms OR the day the day positive test was taken, whichever is earlier
- 4. Return to school on day 6
 - a. If fever free without the use of fever-reducing medicine for 24 hours and symptoms are improving
 - b. If the Antigen test is negative on day 5, a mask is not necessary,
 - c. If the Antigen test is still positive, mask indoors except when eating until the test is negative or through day 10

COVID Exposure

1. Mask is recommended until Day 10 with testing on day 6

2. If symptoms occur, test for Covid 19. If the initial test is negative, a second test within 48 hours is recommended Reference <u>Mass.gov</u>
