As the WPS administration prepares for the 2024-25 Kindergarten registration process, it has been determined that this process will open on Monday, April 22nd and will remain open until Wednesday, May 1st. NOTE: Children must be 5 years of age on or before September 1st, 2024 to qualify for kindergarten placement - WPS Policy

Updated Health Guidelines

Massachusetts Department of Public Health is currently reviewing the <u>updated recommendations for respiratory viruses</u>, including COVID-19. At this time, <u>Massachusetts</u> COVID-19 isolation requirement_remains the same, 5 days following symptom onset or a positive COVID test (day 0 is the first day of symptoms OR the day a positive test was taken, whichever is earlier). We anticipate aligning more closely with the CDC and will notify you when this change occurs.
