- 1. When do you calculate GPA and class rank?
  - a. After midterms and after final exams
- 2. When can we start applying for scholarships?
  - a. Local scholarships are available in early Spring of your senior year on the WHS website
- 3. Where can I sign up for community service?
  - a. Many community service opportunities are available in guidance and posted on our guidance page
- 4. Can I perform community service outside of Winthrop?
  - a. Community service should take place within the Winthrop community. We will not accept community service hours from other towns.
- 5. Can I do all my community service all at once?
  - a. The community service requirement is 15 hours a year, every year. Students must complete 60 years of community service as a graduation requirement.
- 6. What is Early Action versus Early Decision?

  - a. On or after October 1st.
