Spanish II

Spanish II builds upon skills developed in Spanish I, extending the student's ability to understand and express his/herself in Spanish and increasing vocabulary. Typically, students learn how to engage in discourse for information or social purposes, write expressions or passages that show understanding of sentence construction and the rules of grammar, and comprehend the language when spoken slowly. Students may explore the customs, history, and art forms of Spanish-speaking people to deepen the understanding of the culture. This course will be taught at a slower pace.

Prerequisites:

Successful completion of Spanish I.

It is the student's responsibility to collect and make up work. Please check iPass and/or Google Classroom before asking Srta Kelley. ALL grades will be posted in iPass.

Homework:	 Homework is due on Google Classroom each Friday that there is an assignment. Absences do not excuse a student from turning in the weekly homework.
Quizzes:	 Quizzes must be made up within one week of the original quiz date. If you are absent the day before a quiz, you are still required to take that quiz. You may retake quizzes for up to a 70% within one week of receiving your grade. *Only if you score below a 70% on the original quiz.*
Tests:	 Tests must be made up within one week of the original test date. If you are absent the day before a test, you are still required to take that test. You may complete test corrections for up to a 65% within one week of receiving your grade. *Only if you score below a 65% on the original test.*
Projects:	 You are required to submit projects on time to Google Classroom. Even if you are absent from school. You will lose 5 points off of your grade every day that a project is late. This includes weekends. Projects not turned in within 1 month of the original due date will receive a 0%. There are no corrections/re-dos on projects. Your grade is final.

Requests for extensions that are submitted on the due date or the day before will not be allowed.

Classroom Rules:

- Please do your best to arrive on time. If you must go to your locker, please come to class first.
 - I take attendance immediately after the announcements each morning. If you are not in class by then, you will be sent to the office for a late pass.
- Come to class fully prepared each day. See **students' responsibilities** for more details.
